SEAM ALLOWANCES & OTHER INFO

Seam and hem allowances are 3/8" or 1cm deep.

All seams are sewn right sides together unless otherwise stated.

\$kills needed include: gathering fabric; working a narrow hem.

ABOUT THIS STYLE

This garment is a simple wrap-over style, to be worn as a skirt or as a dress. you can choose to leave the edges of the gathered tiers and/ot the hemline raw for a casual look.

This is one of the few times we'll say, don't bother making a muslin for this...as the fit is super-adjustable due to the wrap over and ties, all you have to do is choose your usual HotPatterns size.

FABRIC & NOTIONS REQUIRED


Sizes 6-8-10-12-14-16 need around 3 yards or 2.75 m of 60"/150cm wide fabric; sizes 18-20-22-24-26 need around 3 1/2 yards or 3.20 m of 60" or 150cm wide fabric.

We don't recommend this style for narrow, i.e. 45" or 114cm wide fabric.

1a Start by preparing the waistband & ties.


Join the center back waistband to the front waistband pieces at the short edges; then join the ties to the front waistband pieces, again at the short edges, to make a very (very!) long strip.

SUGGESTED LINING CUTTING LAYOUT lay the fabric open for this layout.



IMPORTANT make sure that you leave the right side seamline open between the notches marked on the pattern; this creates the opening for the waist tie to thread through.

Press all the seams open.

Join the fronts to the back at the side seams; press the seams open.


Work a row of gathering stitches along the top edge of the skirt front/back piece.



Repeat step 2, this time using the back & front bottom tiers.



Draw up the gathering stitches along the top of the bottom tier piece, and matching side seams to side seams, join the bottom tier to the skirt. Press the seams open.



Hem the bottom and front edges of the tiered skirt; press the hems.

Repeat step 4, this time gathering the top edge of the skirt to fit the waistband of the skirt.




